The pickup in global growth anticipated in the April World Economic Outlook remains on track, with global output projected to grow by 3.5 percent in 2017 and 3.6 percent in 2018.

US economic rebound improves global economic outlook while growth in Europe and China is stable.

Commodity prices showed a sharp upturn during 2016 and early 2017 period, however vulnerabilities remain, of which softer Chinese industrial production and a stronger US Dollar pose the most significant in the near term.

Growth prospects in Sub-Saharan Africa improve on the back of commodity price recovery.

South Africa faces unique challenges. Growth of 2.5% was recorded for Q2 2017. CPI of 4.6% and PPI of 3.6%.

In the North West province 978 000 people were employed with an unemployment rate of 27.2%.

The economy in the North West province has been affected positively by the increase in commodity price and increase in agricultural production.

The tuckshop and retail economy of the province's VTSD areas were propelled into a new era when the first mini shopping centre and wholesale warehouse were opened by Premier Sisa Mahumapelo in the JB Marks local municipality.
