Perseverance soon paid off when one of the local schools awarded Jayne with a tender to manufacture school uniforms.

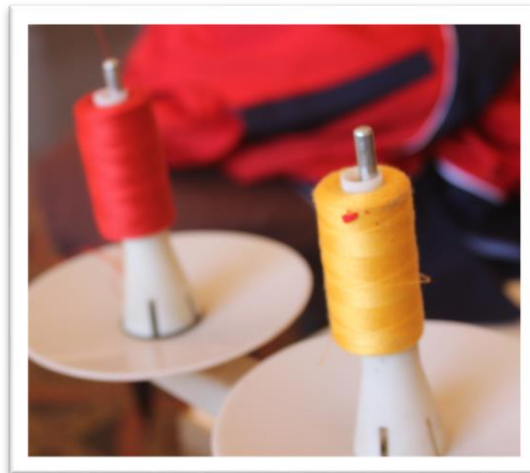
