The conference theme is: "Rebuilding the Province through the promotion of Trade and Infrastructure Investment".



The steady expansion since mid-2016 continues, with global growth for 2018/19 projected to remain at its 2017 levels.

Global growth is projected at 3.7 percent for 2018 - 2019.

South Africa faces unique challenges. Structural factors to impede SA's growth performance in the short to medium term include a weakening fiscal position, declining foreign direct investment, weaker business environment and consumer vulnerability.

For the first time since 2017 the North West's unemployment rate was higher than the national rate of 27.5%, reaching 28% in Q3.

In terms of Foreign Direct Investment in the North West received 1.4% (16) of all projects (1135) in South Africa between 2003 and August 2018.

This represents 2.3% (R 23.7 billion) of the capital investment and 3.8% of jobs (7805 jobs).

The President indicated in the State of the Nation address that he wants the South African ranking in the Doing Business to improve to the 50th position from where it is at 82nd position, in order to attract more investment into the country.
