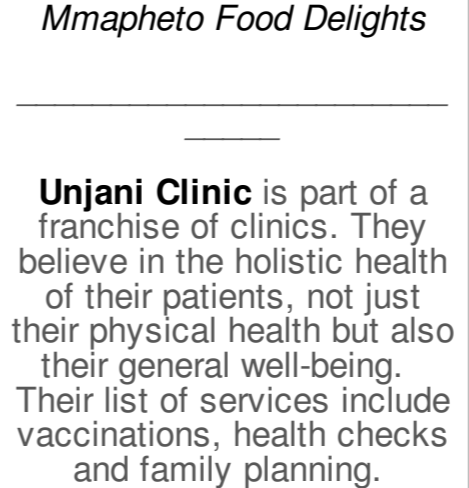

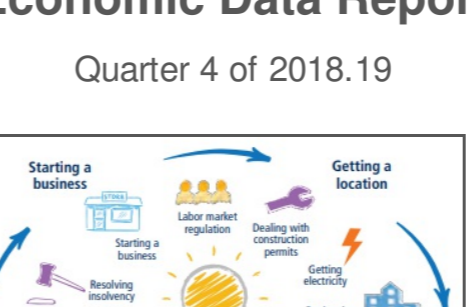

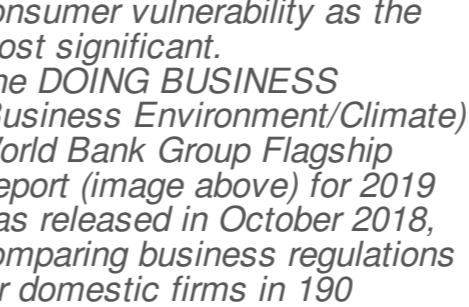

The global expansion has weakened. The global economy is projected to grow at 3.5 percent in 2019 and 3.6 percent in 2020, that is 0.2 and 0.1 percentage points below last October's projections. South Africa faces unique challenges. Structural factors to impede South Africa's growth performance in the short to medium term include: a weakening fiscal backdrop, slowing investment, weaker business environment and consumer vulnerability as the most significant.

The DOING BUSINESS (Business Environment/Climate) World Bank Group Flagship Report (image above) for 2019 was released in October 2019, comparing business regulations for domestic firms in 190 economies. The aggregate ranking on the ease of doing business benchmarks each economy's performance against that of all other economies in the Doing Business sample.
