Kaninvest, trading as Kopano Kwik Cash, was founded in 2001 from the need to deliver financial assistance to those in rural areas who would not normally have access to the same quality financial help as their counterparts in the city. With 20 branches in South Africa and 13 branches in Botswana, the business has evolved and now delivers powerful online help to all in the SADEC area.

Kopano Kwik Cash is a registered credit provider (NCRCP 335) and conforms to all the laws and regulations of The National Credit Regulator. Personal data is protected and handled confidentially as prescribed. Kopano Kwik Cash also uses confirmation technologies such as fingerprint verification through biometrics and cell phone verification to confirm that the only person that takes out a loan is, in fact, the individual in question.

How does it work?

Short Term Loans range from 1 to 6 months. Their aim is to get cash-strapped individuals out of trouble quickly and not into bigger trouble by over-indebting them.

The following is needed to apply for a short-term loan:

- Payslip of the past month
- Three months' bank statements
- Proof of identification through ID book or Identification Card.
- Your bank card to swipe and authorise the debit order
- Your cell phone and your cell phone number to verify your contact details.

Being part of the Kopano Kwik Cash Family has its perks as employees, which Neo and Simplicity at the Lehurutshe branch can attest to. They have been trained to communicate efficiently (which gives their business an edge over competitors), give friendly and quality service and build good customer relations. Team Building with the other branches also assists in their personal growth and that of the company by sharing problems, finding solutions and sharing trade tips.
